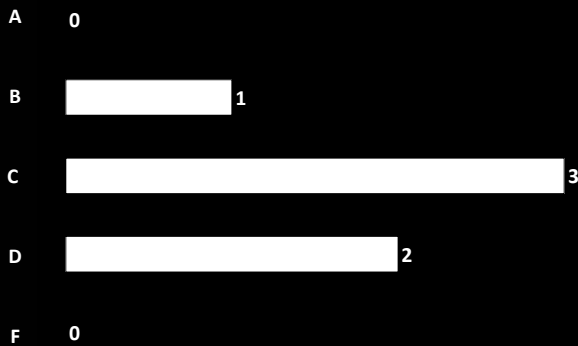

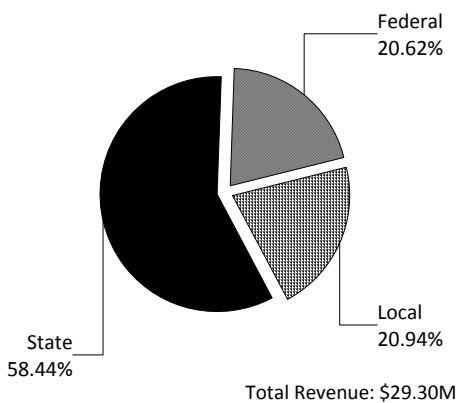

**Revenue Sources**



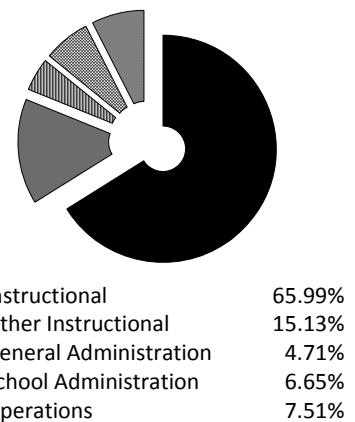
